National Grid will soon be starting vital gas pipe replacement work in your street. **This leaflet contains important information** about the work, so please keep it safe as you may need to refer to it during our works.

What we are doing in your area?

National Grid look after the pipes that bring gas to your home or business. It's our job to make sure everything is running as it should.

Balfour Beatty, on behalf of National Grid will be carrying out gas pipe work to enable United Utilities to continue their project to lay a new 6.5km sewer to improve water quality in Lake Windermere.

We will be diverting the gas pipe that runs along the A592 between Storrstwaite and Ferry Nab to allow the new sewer pipe to be laid in the most safe and efficient way.

Our work will be completed in 3 phases, we have almost completed our first phase on the A592 located by Storrstwaite, we will soon be starting phase 2, moving along the A592 to Storr's Park before finishing our work at Ferry Nab.

To make sure you are kept up to date, we will be communicating with you on each phase of the work.
