We will hold all the above information for 3 months after the membership has lapsed or the person ceases to represent an organisation.

What we will use the information for

The information we hold will only be used to convey information regarding:

- Notices/minutes convening General and Annual General meetings.
- Information received from the Cumbria Constabulary pertinent to the business community.
- Business Watch.
- Windermere Town Council.
- Cumbria County Council
- Other partnership agencies the Secretary deems appropriate.
