Your Priorities - What we did

Windermere Town:

Anti Social Behaviour is the number one community concern, it is a priority issue for the Community Team. We are working with partners including Connexions, Young Cumbria and CADAS to address the issue. We have held a range of positive activities for young people. Notable examples include a Football tournament which attracted over 40 participants. Training sessions take place every week at South Lakes Leisure Centre in Kendal. The Wheelhouse Club hosted a Halloween Disco for young people, which was well attended and received very positive feedback from all involved.

We are working to encourage Neighbourhood Watch Schemes in the area and are keen to support groups who would like to establish their own Watch. Please contact the community team for any further information or advice
