### Windermere Town:

PC Hunter and PCSO Blacow have run many diversionary tactics in our area to encourage positive behavior in young people and reduce incidents of antisocial behavior. Diversionary days out include Army camps to give local youths chance to try something new and positive and to encourage beneficial interaction with the local neighbourhood policing team.
