

SERVICES THROUGH OXENHOLME DURING THE EMERGENCY PERIOD

WCML: AvWC

There are basically four trains per hour <u>from Euston</u> – one each to Glasgow, Liverpool, Manchester and Wolverhampton. AvWC is not operating to Edinburgh (see TPE service)

First train from Euston 05:31 with the last train north at 19:30. Some departures are at 10-past the hour <u>Southbound</u> the service operates from 06:20 until 20:30

All trains call at Crewe and Oxenholme in both directions

TPE

The basic service is 2-hourly from Preston to Edinburgh, with the first two north starting back from Manchester Airport and an additional train at teatime from Piccadilly to Glasgow.

The last train north leaves Preston at 19:05.

<u>Southbound</u> there is an Oxenholme starter at 07:08 to Piccadilly, Lancaster has an extra one at 06:28.

The first service departs Edinburgh at 08:12, then it's 2-hourly until 20:11.

There is an additional train from Glasgow at 17:08.

NORTHERN

There are cancellations on many routes.

The South Cumbria Barrow/Windermere service with Manchester Airport continues to operate, but for a reduced length of the day, calling additionally at Leyland and Euxton. All will call at Lancaster. On the Lakes Line, the first train through from Manchester Piccadilly at 06:48 departs Oxenholme at 08:18, returning at 9:09 from Windermere to Manchester, then 2-hourly until 18:56.

The last inbound service is the 16:29 from Manchester Airport (Piccadilly 16:54)

Weekends similar, with earlier WCML closedown on Saturday evening and late start on Sundays as usual
