Financial Statement:

The Treasure present to the Meeting the Income and Expenditure Account for the Windermere & Bowness Chamber of Trade for the year ended 30th September 2006. This was accepted and passed by those present.

Chairman's Report:

South Lakes Development Trust Report:

Bill Johnson pointed out as he had not been informed of any meetings of the SLDT he could not make a report.

WoW Report:

Barry Butler gave a report on the 2006 Windermere on Water Festival. He went onto point out that for 2007 there would be a total spend of around \pounds 30k - \pounds 40k which would not include the street entertainment. He said the sponsorship was being sought for these activities.

The 2007 festival was beginning to be planned and the Chamber of Trade would have representation.

Grant Proposal:

It was proposed, seconded and agreed that the Chamber of Trade should make a grant of £300 to the Winter Lights Group.

Post Office:
