Sculpture Trail

Scott Keenan gave an update on the progress being made and handed out copies of his updated DRAFT notes. There then followed discussion on its contents.

The Secretary reported that he had emailed the membership with the proposals for the Charity and had received positive replies back from a number of members.

Taking these positive replies and the positive response from those assembled, it was agreed:

- 1. That the Sculpture Trail Group should become a charity.
- 2. That the name of the charity should be known as "Windermere & Bowness Chamber of Trade Sculpture Trail Trust."
- 3. That the resolution "That the bank account named Windermere & Bowness BID's Business Current Account (A/c No: 62232525) be changed to Windermere & Bowness Chamber of Trade Sculpture Trail Trust" be adopted. There was unanimous agreement. Barry Butler and Adrian Faulkner signed the document authorising the bank to make the necessary amendment.
- 4. That the Constitution is accepted.

The Secretary handed out to those assembled the document entitled 'Sculpture Trail Trustee Requirements.' Having answered the questions raised, it was agreed that the following persons would become the initial Trustees and assume the following roles:

- a. Scott Keenan would become Chair.
- b. Barry Butler would act as 'stand in' as and when the need arises.
- c. Adrian Faulkner would act as Secretary and Treasurer.
- d. Tony Blaney and Alex Kirby would become Trustees.



Barry Butler then left the meeting having a prior engagement to attend. Scott Keenan took the chair for the remainder of the meeting.

The Secretary reported that there had been "expressions of interest" for grant funding from:
