 - d) Sarah Blacow and Tony have been working to identify vulnerable people to help to ensure they get help with forms for extra financial help. They will do a joint surgery at Booths in August.

Scheme to care for your vulnerable Neighbour is really important and the WCSP agreed that this was to be a priority in notes in the Hub. Age UK have closed the Ambleside Dementia Day care. They are working with the Parish Council to establish a "2 in 1" carers and Dementia session. The service will enable carers to meet and get advice while the dementia patients will get support and care.
