Statement from Richard Blackwell, Director, Water Resources West. WaterResourcesWest.co.uk

To ensure we have a long term plan to meet future water needs a collaborative group has formed to join-up planning for water resources across the cross border catchments between England and Wales, the North West of England, and the Midlands. We are Water Resources West and over the next three years we will be developing plans for sustainable and resilient water supplies for all abstractors across this wide area. We will be looking ahead to the 2050's and beyond. To help us do this we need to make sure that we have reflected the interests of all stakeholders and the only way we can do that is to ask you your opinions and views on the plan.

To start this engagement, today we are publishing an initial view of water resources required by the 2050's. Over this time our region's water needs will be affected by climate change, economic growth, an increasing population and our ambitions to improve the environment. We want to make sure that opportunities for economic growth and environmental improvement are supported by sustainable and resilient water supplies. This means that we will need to continue making more efficient use of the water we have and we will also need to identify some new sources of water to meet our needs.
