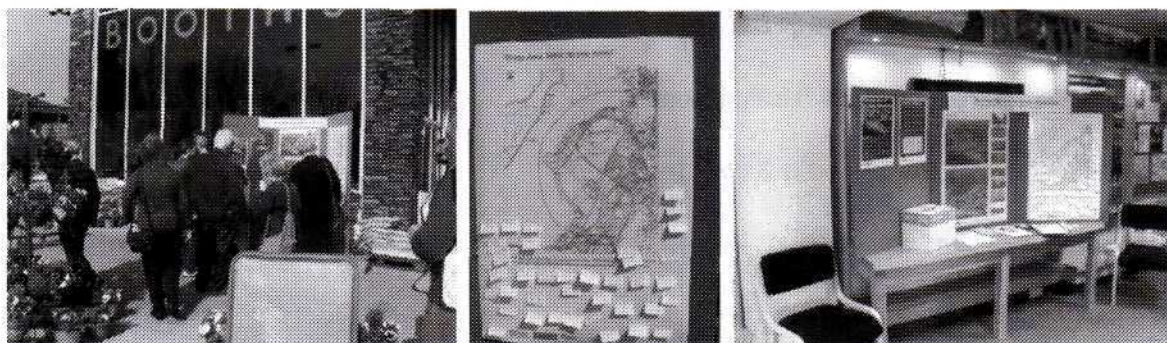


Bowness Bay & the Glebe Masterplan

The 'Blank Sheet of paper Approach'

During recent consultation undertaken between 24th April and 9th May, a successful community engagement exercise was delivered with a basic exhibition held within Booths and the Bowness TIC. As in your agenda packs, the community were presented with display material illustrating images of the area and a study area plan, as well as summary information about the project. All this information was also available online and widely publicised. Many feedback forms have been received and these are being built into a Consultation Feedback Report. However, attendees were also asked to leave any priority issues they had about Bowness Bay and the Glebe on post it notes on an area plan, as pictured.



In total, 86 comments were left, and a summary of these is now presented for your information:

- Toilets! Please clean and keep open (x 18 comments)
- Baby changing facilities in toilets
- Get rid of the horrible building which contains the casino and amusements / Demolish of Shepherd's Aquarius Building – its really an eyesore! (x 7 comments)
- Provide better disabled access (x 2 comments). More disabled parking
- No more shops please
- Please provide more for locals to do, libraries
- Cheaper public transport
- Need decent litter bins (x 3 comments)
- Don't turn it into a theme park (x 2 comments)

- Braithwaite Fold car park should be used more and be a better quality
- Too many tourists spend their time looking for parking and clogging the streets
- Te pin bowling, picture house
- Good if more for the community to do!
- More seasonal events i.e. Christmas, Halloween, food fairs, farmers market etc (x 2 comments)
- Do not close Glebe Road
- More parking please and cheaper!
- Re-instate and re-furbish the drinking fountain
- Provide a fun fair, playground (x 3 comments)
- More usage of band stand
- Remove the burger stand (x 2 comments)
- Get rid of the road train
- Celebration of beauty
- Provide more seats at Cockshott Point
- Half the size of Pitch 'n' Putt and plant meadow orchard / trees for everyone's enjoyment
- Give the young something to do
- Promenade – make the "ground" attractive street furniture etc (similar to Morecombe but sympathetic to Bowness)
- Look at Kes Wilt waterfront redevelopment
- Provide Herring Bone car parking on Glebe Road
- More seating
- Lake view needs painting please (x 3 comments)
